

212 km North of Kolkata. In 1901, a school in traditional Gurukul system was found by Nobel Laureate Rabindranath Tagore. Presently The Vishwabharati University is the centre of international studies and culture.

Bishnupur

152 km form Kolkata in Bankura district was the capital of ancient Hindu Malla dynasty. Famous for Terracotta Temple, tussar silk, baluchri sarees, etc. Kamarpukur, the birthplace of Sri Ramkrishna Paramhans and Joyrambati, the birthplace of Saradadevi are on the way.





Sunderbans

120 km South of Kolkata on the lower of Gangetic West Bengal is the World's largest mangrove forest and the home of world famous Royal Bengal Tiger, largest deltaic crocodiles, dolphins, king cobra, pythons, giant turtle, deer and the variety of migratory birds.

Shankarur & Digha

183 km form Kolkata, a virgin beach as yet and is famous for flat hard beaches all over with casuarinas plantations along the coast.



HOW TO REACH

By Train

Kolkata railway station (formerly known as Chitpur railway station) is the newest of the six intercity railway stations serving Howrah and Kolkata, West Bengal, India, the others are **Sealdah station in Kolkata and Howrah Junction, Shalimar station and Santragachi Junction in western banks of the Ganges.**

- The distance from Kolkata Railway Station to Biswa Bangla Convention Centre is approximately 12.7 km.
- The distance from Sealdah Railway Station to Biswa Bangla Convention Centre is approximately 13.2 km.
- The distance from Howrah Railway Station to Biswa Bangla Convention Centre is approximately 26.4 km.
- The distance from Shalimar Station to Biswa Bangla Convention Centre is approximately 23.9 km.
- The distance from Santragachi railway station to Biswa Bangla Convention Centre is approximately 25.8 km.



By Air

Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport or Kolkata Airport at Dumdum is among the busiest airports in the country in terms of overall passenger traffic. Spread across an area of 2,460 acres, the airport has all the latest facilities. There are three terminals here: domestic, international and cargo, and flights are available for all the major Indian and international destinations. Airlines such as Air India, IndiGo, Jet Airways and SpiceJet have regular flights for Mumbai, Delhi, Lucknow, Agartala, Bangalore, Patna, Ranchi, Aizwal and Chennai. Those travelling to Bangkok, Singapore, Doha, Dubai, Dhaka and Colombo can board flights operated by Emirates, Jet Airways, Singapore Airlines, Thai Airways and Etihad Airways. Upon reaching the airport, travellers can opt for prepaid taxis, autos or buses to reach anywhere in the city. The distance from Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport to Biswa Bangla Convention centre is approximately 10.6 km.
